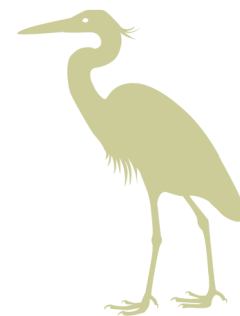
THE WONDERS OF WETLANDS
